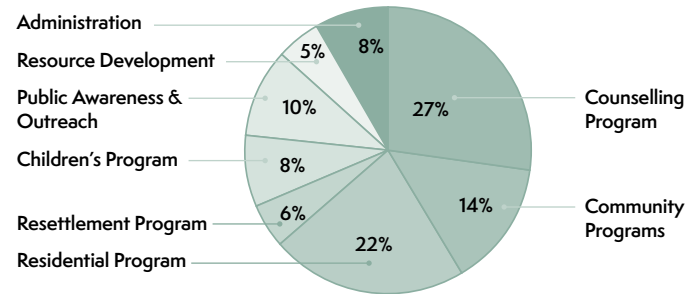


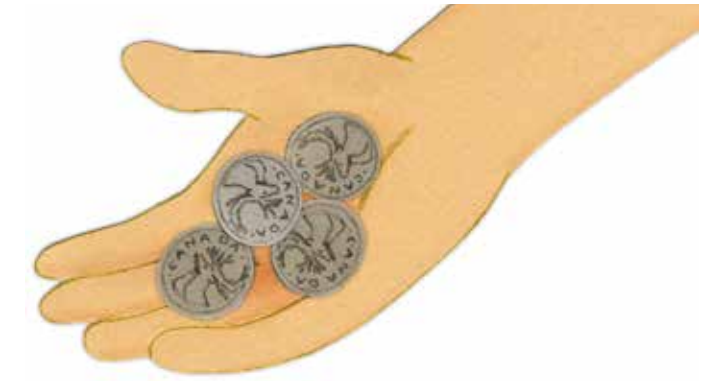

IMPACT REPORT

If every person in Toronto donated \$1, we could operate for 1 year



- 21** individual volunteers
- 19** community fundraisers and drives took place
- 25** thank you cards were received from clients
- 63** women housed
- 65** children housed
- 34** women housed in the private market
- 16** different languages spoken by our families
- 91** women received support from the Resettlement Program
- \$1890⁴²** is the cost of providing JUST shelter for everyone in one day
- \$694⁹³** cost of groceries every week (feeds 30 women and kids)
- 10+** loads of dishes per day

18 hours (average) spent by each client with the Career Developer

158 suits given out to BESS clients

10 BESS Workbooks handed out in the last class

6 Life Skills workshops

3 awards handed out at the BESS Graduation

3 BESS grads hired by our employer partners



- 599** crisis calls answered
- 2³/₄** hours: Average time each counsellor spends per shift on legal advocacy for our clients
- 20** volunteer groups came in to help with dinner, painting, cleaning and other activities
- \$26⁷³** cost of one counselling session
- 4** hours of Women's Counselling groups per week
- 76** board games in the activity room
- 6** fish in the fishtank (Josephine, Thor, Thunderkitty, Terminator, Scrapper, The Janitor)
- 27** costumes in the playroom
- 6** puppets in the playroom
- 384** hours of children's activities
- 1** visit from the Easter Bunny
- 50+** tickets to sports events, concerts, movies and plays donated to our families
- 28** family outings to places like the Toronto Zoo and the Royal Ontario Museum
- 37** families used our Household Boutique to furnish their new homes
